4) Make the connection

1) STAY EDUCATED

Knowing common myths & facts will help you respond to zionist, racist, or pro-boss propaganda. **Scan QR code for resources.**

2) REMEMBER THE CONTEXT

How you know and interact with the people around you will **influence what you can do together**. Co-workers? Friends? Neighbours? Same faith community? Share a hobby?

Context is important for how to have these conversations and how you might work together (e.g., union caucus, book club, direct action, etc.)

When governments fail, workers take action >>>

Do they "not do politics" & want to enjoy their comfort? Everyone deserves safety & dignity. Our comfort in "Canada" is tied to an imperial system that exploits & bombs so a few can profit. **True peace requires solidarity & justice.**



Talking about Palestine

New to talking about politics at work? It can feel scary but we must push past that.

Here are some **tips and resources** for knowing how & when to talk about Palestine.

5) Call to Action

Responses might include apathy, cynicism or pessimism. **Emphasize collective power!** Nothing changes if you don't act! Try to have one action or follow-up: invite them to your next meeting/action join L4P sign a petition. call your MP watch a film

6) Don't let them off the hook

Follow-up. Invite them again. Remind them that nothing changes if they don't act.

7) Remember: you are doing the right thing

Being awkward or uncomfy is normal. Be confident & unapologetic about Palestine. <3
